THE FOUR THREADS

- Play ● Relationship and love ● Safety and belonging ● The more-than-human

First, watch your child: where they go, what they return to, what overwhelms them. The child is the brief.

THRESHOLD

1

Where the day is handed over.

Look for: Coat, shoes, and bag at their reach, and a moment to arrive rather than be rushed.



KITCHEN

2

The real heart of the home.

Look for: A safe spot at your height while you cook, and one real job they can do.



SHARED ROOM

3

Can a child belong in the grown-up room?

Look for: One low basket or corner that is clearly theirs, and play allowed to spread.



NIGHT

4

Rest, safety, and the dark.

Look for: Warm low light, an enclosed sleeping spot, and the door in view.



BATHROOM

5

Dignity in the dull rooms.

Look for: Tap, towel, and toothbrush within reach, and a step where one is needed.



OUTDOORS

6

The world beyond the door.

Look for: Unhurried time outside, and a route, tree, or patch of ground that is theirs.



Change one thing per room.

Begin with the change that gives your child the most, usually reach, retreat, or proximity.
